

Roulette Picture Bets Cheat Sheet

Neighbours, sectors, James Bond, two dozens and two columns - Kim Birch

Neighbour Bets

Chosen number + N pockets each side on the wheel. Common setting: 2 each side, 5 chips total. Each covered pocket pays 35:1 (standard straight-up payout).

Sector Bets (single-zero wheel)

Voisins du Zero: 17 numbers, 9 chips. **Tiers du Cylindre:** 12 numbers, 6 chips. **Orphelins:** 8 numbers, 5 chips. **Jeu Zero:** 7 numbers, 4 chips.

James Bond Layout

Three-chip pattern covering 25 of 37 pockets: 140 on high 19-36, 50 on six-line 13-18, 10 straight-up on 0. Total stake 200. Uncovered 12 numbers (1-12) lose the whole stake.

Two Dozens / Two Columns

Two chips on any two dozen boxes (or column boxes) cover 24 of 37 numbers at 2:1. Wins ~64.9% of European spins. Losing spins cost 2 units.

Reminder

Picture bets change **where** chips go, not the underlying odds. Every roulette bet keeps its fixed house edge.
