European / French Single-Zero Wheel

Wheel vs Table

Table layout is built for chip placement (3 columns × 12 rows). Wheel layout is built to alternate red/black, odd/even and high/low around the rim. They do not match - that is what sector and neighbours bets are for.

Sectors (single-zero wheel)

Voisins du Zero (17 numbers, 22 → 25 through 0). **Tiers du Cylindre** (12 numbers opposite zero). **Orphelins** (8 numbers in two short arcs). **Jeu Zero** (7 numbers tight around 0).

Neighbours Bet

Your chosen number plus N pockets to each side on the wheel. Usually 2 each side (5 pockets total).
